Instructions for Use of Miscarriage Recovery Packet™ and Burial Vessel 🖳

If you received a Miscarriage Recovery Packet™ (colander, etc), for use during your miscarriage to collect your baby's remains, visit www.covenantresources.org/care for use info.

If you received a Burial Vessel, you can place your baby in the vessel and fill the vessel with saline solution or contact lens solution. After replacing the lid, you can lay the vessel on its side to observe your baby. Visit www.covenantresources.org/care for more information.

If you are having an early miscarriage, it may be difficult to find your baby. Some women collect any solid matter that is discharged and place it in a vessel for burial. If the baby is not able to be seen, you do not need to add the saline or contact lens solution.

Beware of using automatic flush toilets, to prevent accidentally losing your baby if he or she is suddenly delivered while you are using the restroom.

Did You Know?

- A miscarriage is when a baby is lost prior to 20 weeks gestation.
- You are not alone. Ten to 20% of known pregnancies end in miscarriage.
- You can name your baby even if you do not know if your baby was a boy or girl.
- You can bury your baby and potentially at no cost to you.
- If you miscarry, you have the right to bury your baby's remains even if the miscarriage happens in a medical facility or the baby goes to pathology for testing.
- Always check with state and facility guidelines regarding obtaining and burial of your baby's remains.
